Rules for Summer School

This document serves as a summary overview of the summer school rules. You may download a complete copy of the ESC Student Handbook for details of rules that apply during the regular school year. Following are rules for summer school; however, when issues arise that are not addressed in the rules below, the regular Student Code of Conduct will apply. Parents and students are expected to be familiar with these rules.

Attendance

Students are expected to be in attendance every day that school is in session. It is imperative that students do not miss class.

1. Students enrolled in a High School course are permitted two (2) excused absences before they are dismissed from Summer School. Students will be dismissed from Summer School for any unexcused absences.
2. Student tardies will count as 1/4 of a day of absence.
3. If a student is dismissed from Summer School, registration fees **will NOT be refunded**.

School Rules

The Eaton Community School District student conduct code is recognized as the conduct code for Summer School.

1. Students may not leave the school building from 7:30 AM to 12:00 PM without permission from the Summer School Principal.
2. No use or possession of tobacco, tobacco products, alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons on school property. Violators will be dismissed from Summer School.
3. Hats and other forms of head covering are not to be worn in the building unless as part of religious observance.
4. Only juice or water, in proper containers, may be brought into the building.
5. Snacks are allowed, but must be brought into the building before the school day begins.
6. Students who vandalize school property will be dismissed from Summer School and restitution will be required.
7. Modest and appropriate dress must be worn at all times during Summer School hours. The Summer School Principal will determine appropriateness of dress.

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8. The Preble County Summer School Program would like to emphasize that smoking is not permitted on school grounds. Any student who violates this rule will be dismissed from Summer School and local law enforcement authorities will be contacted.
9. All students are required to abide by the technology Acceptable Use Policy. Details of this policy can be found in the regular Student Code of Conduct, which can be downloaded for review.

NOTE: Students causing discipline problems will be dismissed from Summer School. The Summer School Principal will inform students of consequences and document behavioral incidents. Video may be used to document student behavior.
